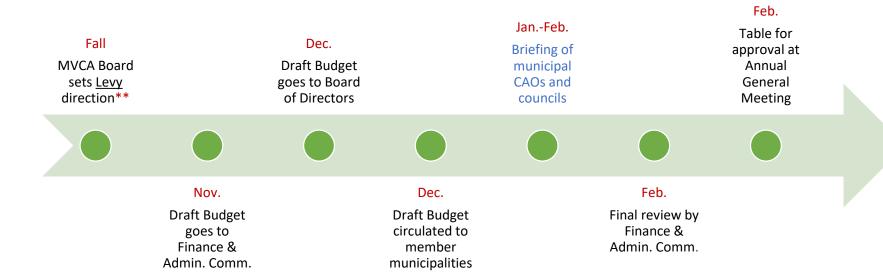

Developing the Budget



**Fall 2022 Direction:

- 3% to the operating budget for inflation (actual closer to 10%)
- 4.5% to the capital budget to implement the 10-year Capital Plan
- 1.5% increase to both to provide for assessment growth

BASE pressure on levy ~4.7%

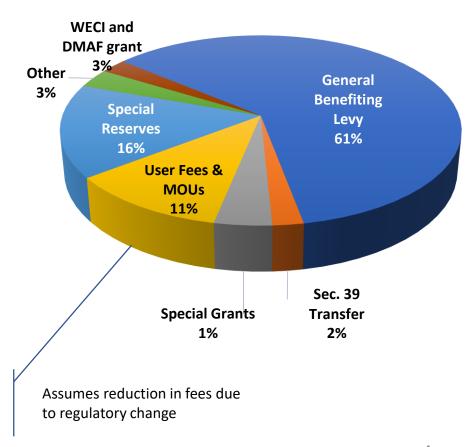

- Includes phase-in of costs for new hires in 2020-2021.
- Municipal levies equal approx. 69% of annual revenue.
- 90% of municipal levy paid by the City of Ottawa.

2023 Municipal Levy

- Apportionment increased from 2.7152 to 2.735%
- Operating \$82,045
- Capital \$17,358

Programs & Services (local highlights)

- O&M of 11 upstream water control structures
- Monitoring of 28 surface water quality/health sites in MM
- O&M of >30 water level and/or flow stations including 2 in Mississippi Mills
- Online access and notification system regarding water levels
- O&M of Mill of Kintail property and museum
 - Museum roof replacement (estm. \$40-60k)
- Stewardship support for lake and community associations
 - Delivery of ALUS program
