## **MAYOR'S REPORT**

February 16, 2021

**General Hillier: Vaccination Update** 

On February 9, 2021, a meeting was held by General Rick Hillier, Minister Elliott and Solicitor General Jones with the mayors of Ontario. The purpose of the meeting was to provide an update on the Provincial Vaccination program. No new information was provided.

General Hillier indicated that knowledge-sharing sessions were underway between the 34 health units who had been given expectations regarding protocols, timings, and priorities. Health Units have prepared plans according to these expectations and have presented to Provincial Vaccination Task Force. He also indicated that at that time, he had no confirmation if or when AstraZeneca may be approved by Health Canada. General Hillier did indicate that if approved, many dosages would be available immediately and that the Vaccination Task Force is ready to respond.
