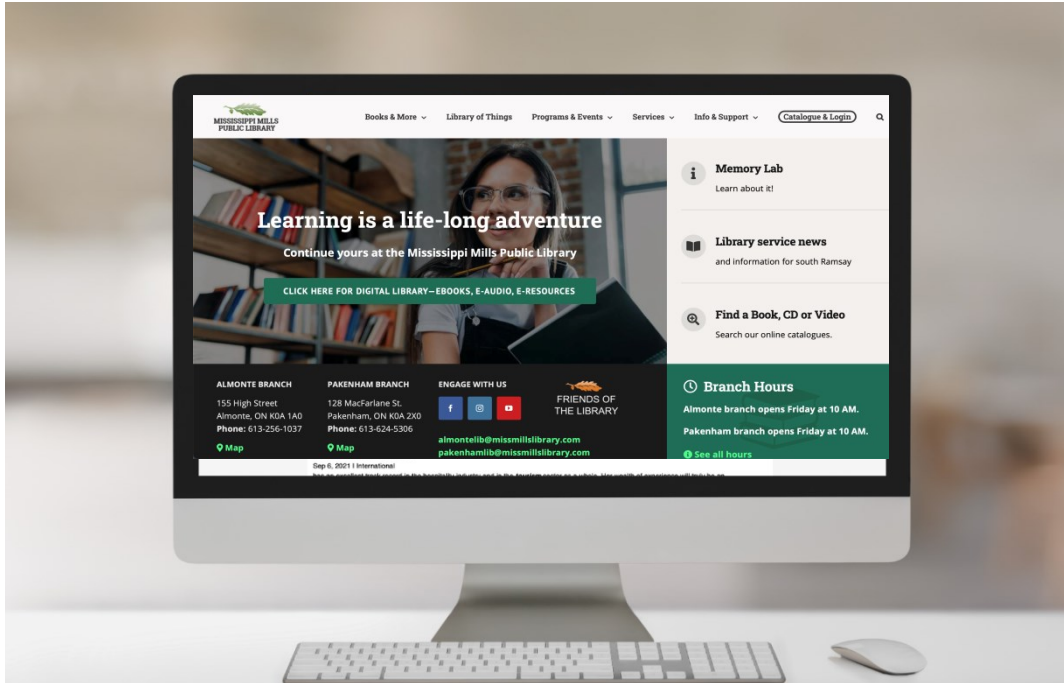

Our Vision



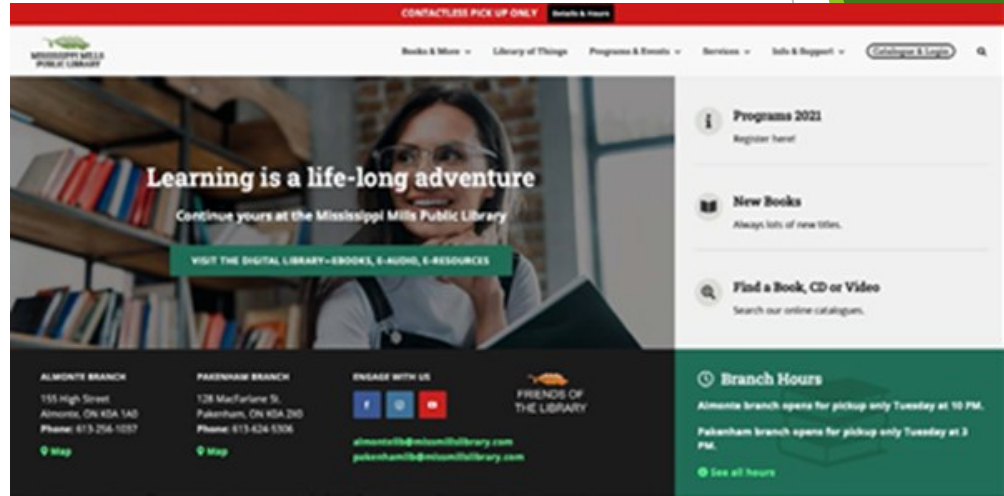

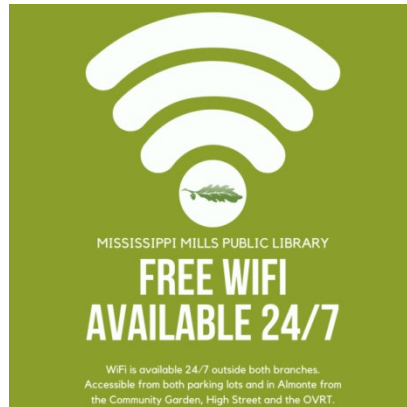

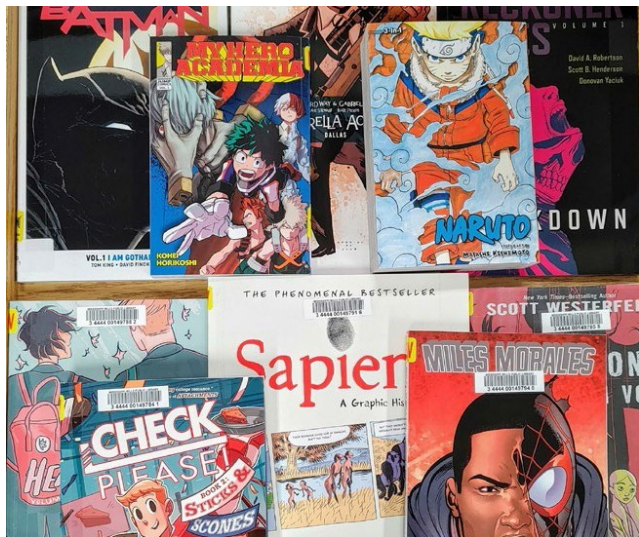
Other tech services available at the library:

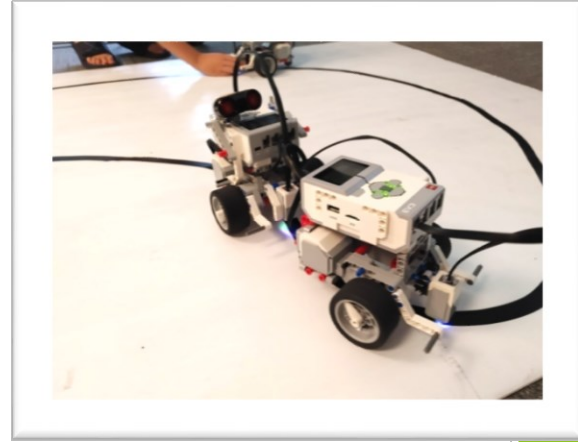

- Collaborated with the Community Economic & Cultural Coordinator and participated in the Mississippi Mills Backyard Garden Program and Puzzle Lending Program.



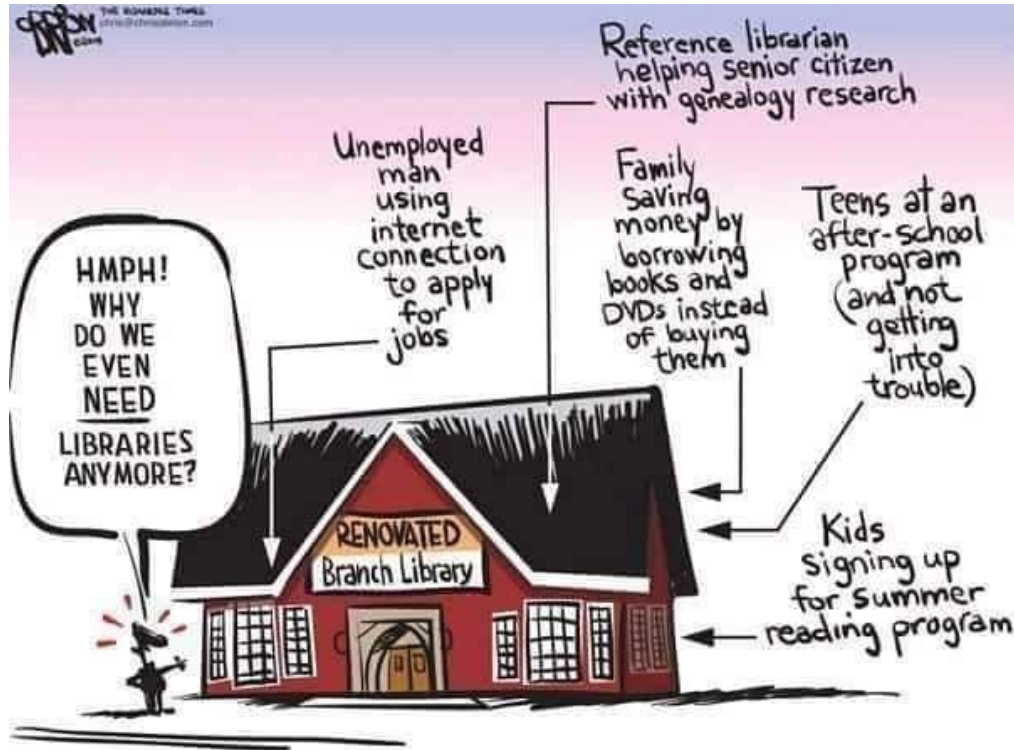
