## **Committee of the Whole: Community Services**

- Update: Lanark County Social Services A Road to Renewal Report: Phase 1, LCSS implemented an immediate response to the COVID-19 emergency
  - Phase 2, Focuses on moving ahead not on reclaiming what was lost, \*Current Stage
  - Phase 3, Creating our new reality, September 8th, 2020 until Date Unknown
- 2) Update: Lanark Lodge. Residents remain cohorted which is driving up costs of staffing along with the need for supervising family visits. Admissions will slowly resume next week, 1 per week, while retaining 4-6 beds for isolation. Staff continue to be swabbed every 2 weeks. Funding announcements from the Province have indicated that the Lanark Lodge funding envelop will not increase for 2021.

- 4) Update: Lanark Transportation: AGM occurred, \$30K surplus. Fares are decreasing so revenues are down significantly as are costs due to less staffing requirements.
